Project Summary

Background

The reason for applying for this project is to provide an international professional experience, an opportunity for academic, professional and personal development for the trainees on the Professional Technical Management Course Computer Systems Programming. The benefit of this experience will be the improvement of technical skills, the development of soft skills, autonomy, the improvement of language skills, future opportunities in the labour market and cultural development.

Objectives

Implementing the project gives trainees contact with emerging technologies, new programming languages, networks and computer security. Strengthen soft skills such as communication, teamwork, creativity and problem-solving. Encourage autonomy, responsibility and the ability to adapt to different realities. Create networking opportunities, opening doors to future job opportunities and strengthening the school's links with the European technology sector.

Impact

The expected results are that this type of experience will serve to enrich the trainees' training programme, and that they will acquire technical, professional and cultural skills that will make them better prepared for their educational and professional journey. The aim of this short-term mobility is for trainees to achieve a 50% rate of integration into the labour market in their area of training after one year of successfully completing the training cycle.
